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# Benefits of the AP Program

1. Prepare for the rigor of college and post-secondary coursework
2. Earn college credit by doing well on AP Exams (3+ score)

3. Save money
  - a. AP Exams cost **\$94** each (AP Seminar/Research = \$142 each)
  - b. UNR = \$233 per credit (NV residents)
  - c. Michigan = \$612 per credit (MI residents)
  - d. Texas = \$483 per credit (TX residents)
  - e. Georgetown = \$2,310 per credit (private)
4. Save time and graduate from college sooner

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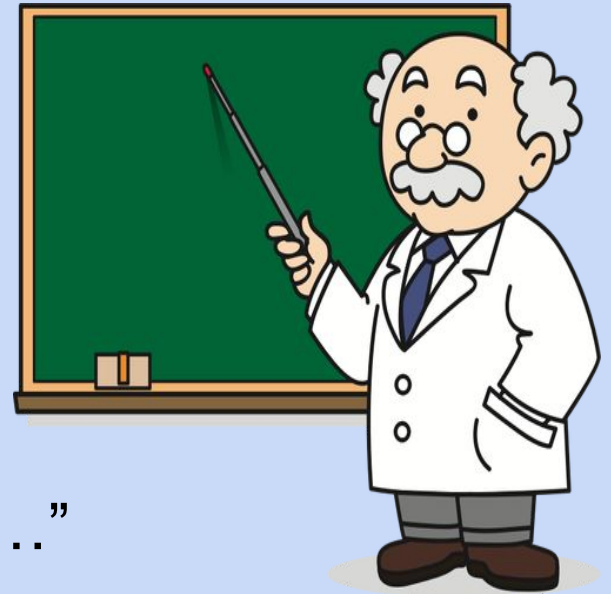
# AP Timeline

- February 2020: Course Selection - with Counselor
- August 2020: Create AP Account/Join Class - with Teacher
- Sept-Oct 2020: Make AP Payment - to Banker
- March 2020: Make Final Payment - to Banker
- May 2021: Take AP Exams - Student
