NSC/LHS Dual Credit Program

- Nevada State College is accredited by NHSE (Nevada System of Higher Education)
- NSHE accredits also CSN, UNLV, UNR, etc.
- Students taking Dual Credit courses have the opportunity to earn high school credit and college credit simultaneously
 - Students must earn a semester grade of “C” or better in order to receive college credit for the course.
- Must have a minimum of a 3.00 Weighted GPA to participate in the Dual Credit Program

Cost of NSC Dual Credit Courses

- NSC NSHE # Application Fee
 - \$30 one time fee
- NSC Dual Credit Tuition Fall 2019/Spring 2020
 - \$25 per credit hour
 - 3 credit hour course would cost **\$75.00** with no fees
- CSN Tuition Fall 2019
 - \$102.75 per credit hour (Lower Division (000-200 level courses))
 - 3 credit hour course would cost **\$308.25** plus fees
- UNLV and UNR Tuition Fall 2019
 - \$233.00 per credit hour
 - 3 credit hour course would cost **\$699.00** plus fees
