Here are several tips and reminders from the Dean's Office to help you be informed on how to conduct yourselves when you are here at Liberty High School. Have a great school year and please do not hesitate to call the Dean's Office if you have any questions.

ENTRANCE

In order to optimize safety and security, students must **ONLY** enter campus in the front doors by the flag pole or thru the bus lane entrances (The bus lane entrances will be locked when the day begins). All other entrances will be locked during the school day.

CLOSED CAMPUS POLICY

When in school, students are not to leave campus for any reason. During lunch, students are to remain in the cafeteria or in the quad only. Students found anywhere outside of the main quad and are not going class are in violation of this policy. Students who drive cannot access their vehicles during the school day and if they do, this is also a violation of this policy. **All** violators will be sent to the Dean's Office, searched and may be RPC'd.

STUDENT ID CARDS

Our continued effort into having a safe and secured environment is important to the administrative team. All students must have their student ID cards on them. You may use last year's ID cards until your new ones will be ready in September. If you do not have your student ID with you, you will be asked to sign in as you enter or leave school.

ATTENDANCE

In order to be successful, you must attend school regularly. You will jeopardize your class credit if you are habitually absent. You will not be approved for a **driver's permit** if you have 7 or more unexcused absences. Please turn in parent/doctor's notes to Rm 400. If you do not bring in a note, you will be issued a Truancy Letter for each unverified absence.

DITCHING CLASS/ TARDIES

If you are ditching certain class periods, it is treated as an absence in the class. Ditching class(es) is a serious offense and often leads to more violations. Immediate disciplinary action may be required. Being on time to class is expected of you. Follow your classroom Tardy Policy. If you are tardy to class frequently, you will be assigned a Dean's Detention.

ACADEMIC HONESTY POLICY

Liberty takes Honesty and Integrity very seriously. Just as in your own family, you must trust each other and help each other learn and grow. If you violate that trust, it is a hard matter to correct. Your English teachers will go over Liberty High School's Academic Honesty Policy. If you **violate the policy**, you will be referred to the Dean's Office.

DRESS CODE

The Dress Code policy is located on the school's website. Violation of the policy will require students to change their clothing so they are in proper attire and frequent violators will receive after school detention.

FIGHTING

The safety of all students at Liberty High School is paramount. Zero tolerance for students who choose to fight on our campus. Our stance on fighting is simple, if you are involved in a fight you will be suspended for **10 school days**.

Safety and security are all our responsibilities. If you see something that is unsafe, report it immediately to a teacher or staff member.
